- 1. The Applicant seeks a stay in relation to the steps required by the December 17, 2015 Reasons for Judgment ("the Judgment Under Appeal") and in relation to application of the revised terms of the OPGT's appointment in this matter as set out in the Judgment Under Appeal, pending outcome of the within appeal;
- 2. Such further and other relief as Counsel may request and this Honourable Court may order.

#### Grounds for making this application:

- 1. Appeal No. 1603-0029AC raises serious issues which affect the interests of the minor beneficiaries and potential minor beneficiaries ("the Affected Minors");
- 2. The Judgment Under Appeal contemplates steps which, if undertaken under the revised terms of the OPGT's appointment and prior to the outcome of the appeal, will cause irreparable harm to the interests of the Affected Minors and to the public interests operative in this matter;
