## WRITTEN QUESTIONS OF SHAWN THERESA AUGER

- Do you acknowledge that your answers to these questions are affirmed as being true, and 1. may be treated in the same fashion as answers given at aquestioning on Affidavit?
- Do you acknowledge that these questions relate to your Affidavit sworn on September 2. 30, 2011 (the "Affidavit") in the within proceedings?

- 3. With respect to paragraph 11 of your Affidavit, you state that on January 3, 1992, Chief Walter Patrick Twinn confirmed your membership resignation with the Sawridge First Nation. Attached to these Written Questions as Appendix "A" is a Release from Shawn Teresa Mandel dated June 26, 1991 (the "Release"). Are the signatures on the third page of the Release, above the words "Applicant", your signatures?
- 4. Attached as Appendix "B" to these Written Questions is an Agreement between Shawn Theresa Mandel, the Government of Canada and the Sawridge Indian Band, signed by Shawn Theresa Mandel on December 1, 1991 (the "Agreement"). Is the signature on page 2 of the Agreement, above the name "Shawn Theresa Mandel", your signature?
- 5. The Agreement contemplates the payment of a per capita share from the Sawridge Indian Band Capital and Revenue accounts. Attached as Appendix "C" to these Written Questions is a letter dated March 6, 1992 from Jim Sisson (Indian and Northern Affairs Canada) to Chief and Council of the Sawridge Band. The letter indicates that a BCR has been approved in the amount of \$293,943.32 of Capital trust funds and \$27,972.86 of Revenue trust funds, representing one per capita share of the Sawridge Band trust accounts. In or around March, 1992, did you receive a total of \$321,916.18 as your per capita share of the Sawridge Band trust accounts?
- 6. If the answer to question no. 5 is no, please advise whether you ever received a payment of a per capita share from the Sawridge Indian Band trust accounts, and if so, the date and amount of the payment.

APPENDIX "A"

FROM: SHAWN TERESA MANDER (hereinafter referred to as the Applicant)

THE SAWRIDGE INDIAN BAND, ALL MEMBERS OF THE SAWRIDGE INDIAN BAND, AND ALL PERSONS ENTITLED TO HAVE THEIR NAMES ENTERED IN THE BAND LIST OF THE SAWRIDGE INDIAN BAND TO:

(hereinafter referred to as the "BAND")

WHEREAS the Indian Act R.S.C. 1970 C.1-6 as amended, provides that a Band Council may authorize the Minister to make payments out of the capital or revenue moneys to persons whose names become deleted from the Band List of the Band; and

WHEREAS pursuant to this power the Band has passed a By-Law Respecting Payments of capital and revenue moneys to persons whose names become deleted from the Band List of the Band; and

WHEREAS the applicant is desirous of receiving such a payment; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT AGREED that in consideration of the Band authorizing the Minister to make a payment out of the capital and revenue moneys held by the Minister for the benefit of the Band, as set out herein, it is agreed as follows:

- Upon execution of the Release, the Band through its Band 1. Council will pass a Band Council Resolution in a form as set out in the 2.
- The Applicant shall not ever reside on the Sawridge Indian Reserve.

- 3. The Applicant shall not ever apply for membership in the Sawridge Indian Band.
- 4. The Applicant shall withdraw any and all applications which have been made for membership in the Sawridge Indian Band.
- 5. The Applicant hereby applies to the Band Council to have the Applicant's name deleted from the Band list.
- 6. The Applicant hereby surrenders the Applicant's membership in the Sawridge Indian Band.
- 7. The Applicant agrees that the payment out of the capital and revenue monies held by the Minister for the benefit of the Band shall constitute a complete and full payment to the Applicant for all of the rights, interests, benefits and other attributes of the Band Membership which the Applicant is hereby applying to surrender, and for any and all rights, interests, and benefits which are incidental to, connected with or which flow from that membership. Without restricting the generality of the foregoing this clause shall apply notwithstanding that the Applicant may have been or have become entitled to a greater sum in light of the determination of litigation surrounding the validity of the 1985 amendments to the Indian Act and the membership granted by those amendments.
- 8. The Applicant agrees to pay from the Capital and Revenue funds which the Minister pay to the Applicant, all debts which the Applicant owes to the Sawridge Indian Band, including interest thereon, if any.

## **AGREEMENT**

WHEREAS Sawridge and the Government are involved in litigation regarding the control of Band Membership (hereinafter referred to as the "Litigation"); and

WHEREAS the Applicant has applied to surrender her Band Membership in Sawridge and to have her name deleted from the Band List of Sawridge and has agreed with Sawridge to accept a per capita payment of the Band's Capital and Revenue account; and

WHEREAS the Government does not accept Sawridge's membership population number for the purposes of calculating the aforementioned per capita share but instead has its own significantly higher membership population number that it intends to use in making the said per capita payment; and

WHEREAS the Government has refused to make the said per capita payment prior to the resolution of the Litigation unless Shawn Theresa Mandel provides her written agreement with the Government's calculation; and

NOW THEREFORE in consideration of the covenants set out herein the parties agree as follows:

- The Applicant agrees with the calculation of the per capita share on the basis of the total number of individuals on the band list and those pending reinstatement to the list as a result of alleged acquired rights notwithstanding that this calculation will result in a smaller payment to the applicant.
- 2) The Applicant hereby surrenders any right to any further moneys in relation to her membership other than the per capita payment as calculated pursuant to paragraph one.

The Government agrees that the agreement by Sawridge herein is merely for the purpose of expediting the payment of the Applicant and shall not be construed in any way to be an admission of:

- a) the validity of the 1985 amendments to the Indian Act;
- b) the validity of the aforementioned alleged acquired rights; or
- c) that any of the individuals whom the Government alleges are pending reinstatement have the right to band membership.
- The Government shall pay to the Applicant forthwith her per capita share as calculated herein, and waives the right to suspend any portion of the said per capita payment pending the outcome of the litigation.
- The Government, Sawridge and the Applicant all admit and agree that the prompt payment to the Applicant of the said per capita payment shall constitute good and valuable consideration for the purposes of this Agreement. Failing such prompt payment all parties will be inconvenienced to the extent necessary to resolve this situation.
