AFFIDAVIT OF FLORENCE ANN HENRY

Sworn on December 6, 2011

I, Florence Ann Henry of the City of Prince George in the Province of British Columbia swear and say that:

1. I am a descendent of the Sawridge Band No. 454, now known as the Sawridge First Nation (hereinafter referred to as the "Sawridge First Nation" or "Nation"). I am not registered as a member of the Sawridge First Nation.

2. As a descendent of the Sawridge First Nation, this entitles me to the matter brought forward involving the Sawridge Band Inter Vivos Settlement created in 1985 (hereinafter called the "1985 Trust").
3. This matter involving the 1985 Trust has been brought forward to the Court by the five trustees of the 1985 Trust: Bertha L'HIRONDELLE, Clara MIDBO, Catherine TWINN, Roland C. TWINN and Walter Felix TWIN (hereinafter referred to as the "Trustees").
4. The Trustees are seeking the opinion, advice and direction of the Court respecting the administration and management of the property held under the 1985 Trust (hereinafter referred to as the "Advice and Direction Application" as they have expressed concerns;
 - a. Regarding the definition of "Beneficiaries" contained in the 1985 Trust;
 - b. Regarding the transfer of assets into the 1985 Trust.
5. I make this affidavit in support that as a descendent of the Sawridge First Nation that I am a potential beneficiary to the 1985 Trust.
6. I am thereby also entitled to provide my opinion, advice and direction for the definition of "Beneficiaries" contained the 1985 Trust and the transfer of assets into the 1985 Trust brought forward by the Trustees in the Advice and Direction Application.

Background


7. I Florence Ann Henry was born August 16, 1960 into the Sawridge First Nation affiliation to my mother Yvonne Leona Henry nee Paquette (hereinafter referred to as Yvonne Henry) of Slave Lake Alberta.
8. Yvonne Leona Henry (my mother) was born April 6th, 1943. Her mother, my Grandmother Marie Adele Paquette (nee Loyie) was born into the Sawridge First Nation to Philomene Loyer (nee Ward). My Grandmother was recognized as a Status First Nation of the Sawridge Indian Band.

Conclusion



It is through the direct descent of my Grandmother Marie Adele Paquette (nee Loyie), and my blood connection to my Grandmother's lineage that I consider myself a beneficiary to the 1985 Sawridge Trust and therefore should be included in the Advice and Direction application presented before the Court regarding the definition of the beneficiaries and the transfer of assets with the 1985 Trust.
